Dr. A. Pinar Cemeroğlu finished medical school in English in 1988 and her pediatric residency in 1993 both at Hacettepe University School of Medicine. After passing ECFMG 1 and 2 (an examination for foreign medical graduates in USA), she was trained at University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, MI, USA for pediatric endocrinology subspeciality between 1994-1997 and at Yale-Bridgeport Hospital pediatric residency program, CT, USA between 1998-2000. After passing USMLE 1,2 and 3, she passed American Board of Pediatrics in 2000 ve American Board of Pediatrics subboard of Pediatric Endocrinology in 2001 and is still currently certified in both.

After finishing her training, she started working as a pediatric endocrinologist at Helen Devos Children's Hospital, pediatric endocrinology division in Grand Rapids, MI, USA in 2002 and took care of many children with Type 1 diabetes and many others with complex disorders in the area of pediatric endocrinology for nearly 14 years. Helen Devos Children's Hospital pediatric endocrinology division, being the biggest reference center for west Michigan in USA, cared for over 2000 children with Type 1 diabetes, of whom 1000 were on insulin pumps. Therefore, Dr. Cemeroğlu, by working almost 14 years at at Helen Devos Children's Hospital, pediatric endocrinology division, acquired a broad spectrum of experience in the area of Type 1 diabetes and other endocrine disorders in children.

Dr. Cemeroğlu participated in education of medical students at Michigan State University Medical School and pediatric residents at at Helen Devos Children's Hospital. She became an

assistant professor in 2005 and associate Professor in 2007 at Michigan State University School of Medicine. She was awarded the ‘‘best teacher of the year’’ in 2003 and 2005, and ‘‘best Mentor of the year’’ in 2013 by Helen DeVos Children’s Hospital. She was appreciated and liked by her patients and colleagues and was awarded by the votes of her colleagues as ‘‘Best doctor’’ every 2 years between the years 2006-2016 in USA.

She served as a member of the Michigan Pediatric Endocrine Advisory Council (PEAC) for Newborn Screening Program, at University of Michigan, Ann Arbor, MI, USA between 2006-2010.

She was the principle investigator for Helen Devos Children’s Hospital at T1D exchange, which is the largest registry of Type 1 diabetes mellitus in USA and has participated in many multicentric studies. She also finished several individual studies and has written several original articles in the area of Pediatric endocrinology and diabetes.

Dr. Cemeroglu worked as locum tenens at Erlanger Children’s Hospital, Chattanooga, Tennessee, USA in 2016 and relocated in Turkey to work as a pediatric endocrinologist at Başkent University pediatric endocrinology division in Ankara between 2016-2019 where she participated in the training of pediatric residents and medical students and became a professor in 2018. She worked at Ankara Liv hospital for a year between 2019-2020. She is currently a faculty member at Yuksek Ihtisas University School of medicine since 2019. She currently has a private practice of pediatric endocrinology in Ankara, Turkey.
